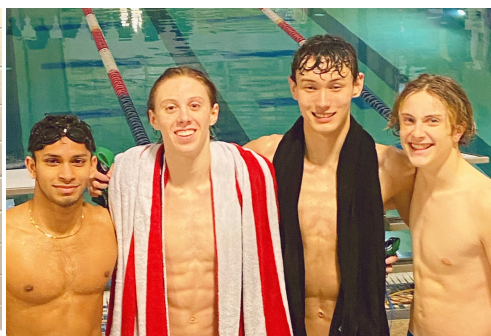


Intense Competition, Strong Swims Highlight Varsity District Meet

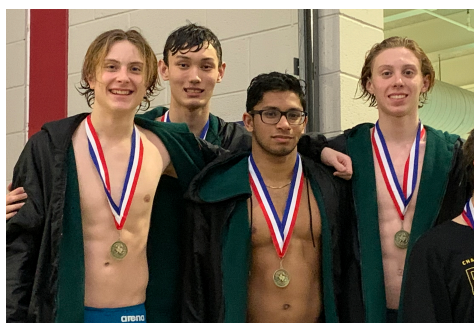
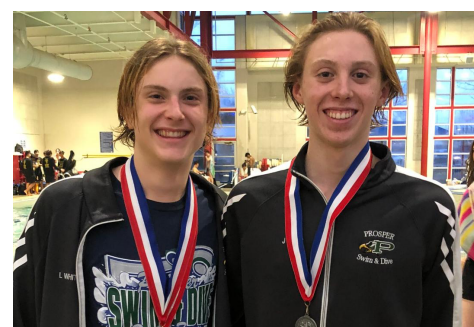

On Friday, January 17th, eight schools met at the Don Rodenbaugh Natatorium in Allen, Texas for the District 7 6A Meet. The district is loaded with powerhouse teams and talented swimmers, making for an exciting and competitive meet. Scoring 52 points, the Lady Eagles finished fifth, while the Varsity Men placed second (101 points) just behind Plano West (103 points). Coach Milne shared that she was pleased with the results, particularly the large number of swimmers that achieved the team's "best time" goal.

Freshman, Maddie Lesko and Sophomore, Sabrina Giachini led the way for the lady Eagles in the individual events with Maddie finishing 2nd in the 200 Free and 3rd in the 100 Free, while teammate Sabrina



finished 5th in the 200 Free. Then, Maddie and Sabrina, along with Junior exchange student, Miku Yoshioka and Junior, Jocelyn Hayes finished 6th in the women's 400 Free Relay with a time of 3:48.38 to close out their district competition.

The Varsity boys put up a number of top 6 individual finishes as well as fielding strong relay teams. Junior, Justice Hunt finished second place in the 200 Free and the 100 Free. Junior, Mithuun Ramesh came in fourth place in the 100 Fly and the 100 Breast. Junior, Saxon Boring finished sixth in the 200 IM. Sophomores, Ethan Hogan (2nd in 100 Back), Kadence Griffin (4th in 200 IM), and Lane White (2nd in 50 Free, 3rd in 100 Free) also finished top 6 and scored key points for the Eagles. Justice Hunt set a new school record in the 100 Freestyle with a time of 47:25.

When it came to the relay events, the Eagles really put their talent to the test. At the start of the meet, Ethan Hogan, Saxon Boring, Mithuun Ramesh and Justice Hunt took 3rd place in the 200 Medley Relay. Then, Saxon Boring, Kadence Griffin, Sam Taylor and Lane White took 4th in the 200 Free Relay. In the final event of the meet, the 400 Free Relay team comprised of Lane White, Samuel Taylor, Mithuun Ramesh and anchored by Justice Hunt put together an amazing come from behind finish to win the event and set the school record with a time of 3:12.35.
